



Boredom line

Find a piece of chalk and draw a long line across the floor of the classroom, or, alternatively, in the schoolyard.

At one end of the line, draw an unhappy smiley – this is where you are often bored at school. At the other end, draw a happy smiley – this is where you are seldom bored at school.

Then all the students stand on the line in the place that suits them personally.

Look at each other and contemplate:

- Am I in the right place?
- Am I surprised to see where some of the others stand?

Ask the classmate next to you:

What will it take for you to move closer to the happy smiley?

- What can you do about it?
- How can I help you?
